

ADULT TREATMENT PROGRAM

The adult outpatient substance use treatment program provides evidence-based treatment for people ages 18 and over. Individualized treatment plans determine length of treatment. Services provided include individual and group counseling, educational sessions, case management services, support system inclusion and sober socialization activities. Secure attachments and supports help clients sustain recovery, so family/support system participation is highly encouraged.

ADOLESCENT TREATMENT PROGRAM

The adolescent outpatient substance use treatment program provides evidence-based treatment and education for people ages 13-17. Clients are screened for eligibility and services include assessments, individual and group counseling, living skills, sober socialization, community resources, and SUD education. Adolescents need support to achieve long lasting recovery so family support system participation is required.

SPECIALIZED WOMEN'S PROGRAM

The Specialized Women's Program provides comprehensive, trauma-informed treatment services to a specialized population of women. With a distinct focus on adult females with dependent children, the women's program was developed with the goals of offering a diverse, yet cohesive, set of services aimed toward outpatient substance use treatment and prevention assistance.

OFFICE-BASED OPIOID TREATMENT (OBOT)

OBOT provides comprehensive medication assisted treatment services for persons who are in recovery from an opioid use disorder. The OBOT team consists of SUD counselors, contracted physicians and pharmacy to provide medical, counseling and prescription services. This is an outpatient, state-funded program available to those who qualify at no out of pocket expense. TCC also maintains Narcan distribution boxes to provide education and free life-saving Narcan to the community.

RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES (RSS)

The goal of Recovery Support Services is to increase the prevalence and enhance the quality of long-term recovery from substance use disorders. The RSS program connects clients with a certified Recovery Support Peer Specialist to provide support, transportation, meetings, and opportunities for socialization and other sober activities. Life skills, wellness, resource gathering, and other help is available.

DRUG AND ALCOHOL ASSESSMENT

Full assessment utilizing multiple screening tools to determine if someone has a substance use disorder and what level of treatment services they could be eligible for. Fees apply, call to schedule.
